Below are the queries/requests for consideration by the prospective bidders, which have been answered by the PITC Bids and Awards Committee I and Philippine Army (PA).

U-NET DISTRIBUTORS CORPORATION in its letter dated 07 January 2021 and received by BAC on the same date via electronic email.

Query 1:

We are writing with regard to the supplemental bid bulletin issued by PITC for the SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF BRAND NEW 147,925 SETS BRAND NEW PHILIPPINE ARMY PATTERN (PHILARPAT) BATTLE DRESS UNIFORM (BDU) WITH BALL CAP FOR THE PHILIPPINE ARMY (PA) WITH REFERENCE BID REF. NO.: MPG-BI-2020-346.

Based on the revised Schedule of Requirements, winning bidder is now required to submit Signed and Notarized Bidder's Certification to Show Proof or Evidence that the Goods are Locally Manufactured. We are in favor of this new pre-requisite since this entails all prospective bidders to guarantee that the said project is indeed being produced in the Philippines.

However, we want to clarify the timeline as to when these supporting documents are to be presented. The SBB stated that these are to be provided by the bidder, if awarded the contract. Meaning upon the receipt of Notice of Award, the winning bidder has to submit the invoices? Standard procurement practice is to purchase raw materials upon receipt of Notice to Proceed, when all post-qualification requirements and tests passed.

Further, item 4 expressed that "if the Procuring Entity (PE) and the Philippine Army (PA) found out that the goods are not locally manufactured by the manufacturer and/or subcontractors if any, the PITC or the PA <u>shall not be compelled to enter into a contract</u> with a bidder". If this last condition holds, does it mean that regardless whether the winning bidder has already received the NOA, NTP and contract, the PITC and/or the Philippine Army (PA) may still opt to not continue with the contract?

Thank you very much and we look forward to your reply on this matter.

BAC1/PA's Reply:

- The duly Signed and Notarized Bidder's Undertaking to Show Proof that Goods are Manufactured in the Philippines will be submitted by the bidder during Bid Opening. However, the supporting documents will be presented during the conduct of Pre-Production Inspection. Please refer to the attached Section VI. 2nd Revised Schedule of Requirements.
- Instead of the Signed and Notarized Bidder's Certification to Show Proof of Evidence in the Manufactured of Goods to be submitted by the Bidder if awarded the Contract, all bidders are required to submit, during Bid Opening, a Signed and Notarized Bidder's Undertaking to Show Proof that Goods are Manufactured in the Philippines per form provided.

Bidders are advised to use and submit Section VI. 2nd Revised Schedule of Requirements and for the Bid Opening on 20 January 2021, 1:00 PM. Also, please use the 2nd Revised Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents as reference.

This **Supplemental/Bid Bulletin No. 2** shall form part of the Simplified Bidding Documents. Any provisions in the Simplified Bidding Documents inconsistent herewith is hereby amended, modified and superseded accordingly.

- The inclusion of the PITC logo is not required in the swatch and/or samples. However, the PITC logo should be included in the actual production of the items.
- The basic material must be the same as the fabric used in the prototype sample. Mismatch of the basic material and fabric of the prototype sample will result to "Failed" technical bid.
