SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF TWENTY (20) UNITS BRAND NEW MOTORBOATS WITH TRAILERS FOR THE BUREAU OF CUSTOMS (BOC)

1. The **Philippine International Trading Corporation (PITC)** and the **Bureau of Customs (BOC)** intend to apply the sum of **Pesos: Two Hundred Ninety Five Million Eight Hundred Eighty Six Thousand Six Hundred Eighty Nine and 80/100 (₱ 295,886,689.80)** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payment under the contract for the **Supply and Delivery of Twenty (20) units Brand New Motorboats with Trailers for the Bureau of Customs (BOC)** Bids received in excess of the ABC shall automatically be rejected at Bid opening.

Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at Bid opening.

2. PITC and BOC now invite bids from MARINA-Licensed Boat Builders Manufacturers/Fabricators with minimum of two (2) years experience in the design and construction of boat for the Supply and Delivery of Supply of Twenty (20) Brand New Motorboat with Trailers for the Bureau of Customs (hereafter referred to as GOODS).
3. The bidding is open to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty (60) percent interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to the citizens of the Philippines.

4. A prospective Bidder should have completed within the last five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids equivalent to:
- One (1) single contract of similar nature amounting to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC of the project; OR
 - Two (2) or more contracts of similar nature equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC for the project the largest of these contracts must be equivalent to at least twenty five percent (25%) of the ABC of the project.

“**Similar contract**” shall refer to the design and construction of any “**vessel**” or “**watercraft**”.

“Vessel” or “Watercraft” shall mean “any barge, lighter, bulk carrier, passenger ship freighter, tanker, container ship, fishing boats or other artificial contrivance utilizing any source of motive power, including fishing vessels, designed, used or not operating as common contract carrier; and, whether supplied commercially, and/or used for law enforcement, or for military purposes.

5. **Delivery Period and Delivery Place:** Delivery of the Prototype within Sixty (60) days after the receipt of Notice to Proceed (NTP) and delivery of nineteen (19) remaining vessels as follows:

6. Open competitive bidding procedures will be conducted using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (R.A.) 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”. All particulars relative to this bidding including Eligibility Checking, Bid Security, Evaluation and Post-Qualification Procedures and Award of Contract shall be governed by **R.A. 9184** and its **2016** Revised IRR.
7. The complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested bidders from Monday to Friday between **9:00AM to 2:00PM** upon payment of a non-refundable fee as indicated above and look for the following BAC Secretariat. However, bidders who previously bought bidding documents for Bid Reference No. GPG-B1-2019-205 and GPG-B1-2019-428 Rebid may acquire the Bidding Documents free of charge upon presentation of official receipt.
