



## INVITATION TO BID

### SUPPLY OF LABOR AND MATERIALS FOR THE REHABILITATION OF NAVAL OFFICER'S QUALIFICATION COURSE (NOQC) BARRACKS, FORT SAN FELIPE, CAVITE CITY FOR THE PHILIPPINE NAVY (PN)

1. The **Philippine International Trading Corporation (PITC)** and the **Philippine Navy (PN)**, intend to apply the sum of **Pesos: Nine Million Three Hundred Sixty Five Thousand Seven Hundred Six and 52/100 (₱9,365,706.52)**, being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the **Supply of Labor and Materials for the Rehabilitation of Naval Officer's Qualification Course (NOQC) Barracks, Fort San Felipe, Cavite City for the Philippine Navy (PN)**.

2. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
3. PITC and PN now invite Contractors with valid and current Philippine Contractors Accreditation Board (PCAB) License with Classification / Category in General Building / General Engineering, **with Minimum Size Range of Small B and Minimum License Category of C or D**, to bid for the Supply of Labor and Materials for the Rehabilitation of Naval Officer's Qualification Course (NOQC) Barracks, Fort San Felipe, Cavite City for the Philippine Navy (PN), (hereinafter referred to as the "WORKS"). The PCAB license must indicate "PCAB registered contractor for Government Projects."
4. The bidding is open to Filipino citizens / sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organization with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging citizens of the Philippines.
5. Prospective Bidders should have completed a single contract similar to the Project amounting to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC adjusted to current prices using the National Statistics Office consumer price index.

However, contractors under Small A and Small B categories without similar experience on the contract to be bid may be allowed to bid if the cost of such contract is not more than the Allowable Range of Contract Cost (ARCC) of their registration based on the guidelines as prescribed by the PCAB. Provided, Bidder submits a duly notarized Affidavit that it has no similar experience on the Contract being bid per **Annex I-B**.

For purposes of this project, "similar contract" shall refer to contracts involving **construction or repair**.

6. Project Completion Period is within **One Hundred Ninety (190) calendar days** upon receipt of the Notice of Site Possession.

7. Open competitive bidding will be conducted using non-discretionary pass/fail criterion as specified in the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (Revised IRR) of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act." All particulars relative to this bidding including Eligibility Checking, Bid Security, Evaluation and Post Qualification procedures and Award of Contract shall be governed by R.A. 9184 and its **2016** Revised IRR.
8. The Invitation to Bid and Bidding Documents may be downloaded from the website of the **Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS)** and **PITC website** at **www.pitc.gov.ph**. Interested bidders may inspect the Bidding Documents upon presentation of proper identification during office hours (8:00AM – 4:00PM) on weekdays only.
9. The complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested bidders from Monday to Friday between 9:00AM to 2:00PM upon payment of a non-refundable fee as indicated above and look for the following BAC Secretariat:
