- The **Philippine International Trading Corporation (PITC)** and the **Philippine Navy (PN)**, intend to apply the sum of **Pesos: Fourteen Million Four Hundred Twenty Three Thousand Seventy Six and 92/100 (₱14,423,076.92)**, being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the **Supply of Labor and Materials for the Rehabilitation of Petroleum, Oil and Lubricants (POL) Dump at Lower Calarian, Zamboanga City & Batu-Batu, Tawi-Tawi for the Philippine Navy (PN)**.

- Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
- PITC and PN now invite Contractors with valid and current Philippine Contractors Accreditation Board (PCAB) License with Classification / Category in General Building / General Engineering, **with Minimum Size Range of Small B and Minimum License Category of C or D with Specialty in Mechanical Works (SP-ME)**, to bid for the Supply of Labor and Materials for the Rehabilitation of Petroleum, Oil and Lubricants (POL) Dump at Lower Calarian, Zamboanga City & Batu-Batu, Tawi-Tawi for the Philippine Navy (PN), (hereinafter referred to as the "WORKS"). The PCAB license must indicate "PCAB registered contractor for Government Projects."
- The bidding is open to Filipino citizens / sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organization with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging citizens of the Philippines.
- Prospective Bidders should have completed a single contract similar to the Project amounting to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC adjusted to current prices using the National Statistics Office consumer price index.

However, contractors under Small A and Small B categories without similar experience on the contract to be bid may be allowed to bid if the cost of such contract is not more than the Allowable Range of Contract Cost (ARCC) of their registration based on the guidelines as prescribed by the PCAB. Provided, Bidder submits a duly notarized Affidavit that it has no similar experience on the Contract being bid per **Annex I-B**.

For purposes of this project, "similar contracts" shall refer to contracts involving **construction or repair of Petroleum, Oils and Lubricants (POL) Depot or Gas Station**.

- Project Completion Period is within **One Hundred Eighty (180) calendar days** upon receipt of the Notice of Site Possession.

7. Open competitive bidding will be conducted using non-discretionary pass/fail criterion as specified in the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (Revised IRR) of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act." All particulars relative to this bidding including Eligibility Checking, Bid Security, Evaluation and Post Qualification procedures and Award of Contract shall be governed by R.A. 9184 and its **2016** Revised IRR.
8. The Invitation to Bid and Bidding Documents may be downloaded from the website of the **Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS)** and **PITC website** at www.pitc.gov.ph. Interested bidders may inspect the Bidding Documents upon presentation of proper identification during office hours (8:00AM – 4:00PM) on weekdays only.
9. The complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested bidders during office hours (8:00am – 4:00pm) but no later than 4:00pm upon payment of a non-refundable fee as indicated above. The Bidding Documents shall be received personally by the prospective bidder or his duly authorized representative upon presentation of proper identification document.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the PhilGEPS and the PITC website, PROVIDED that bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

For the Pre-bid Conference, bidders are encouraged to send their authorized technical representatives or personnel who are familiar with the bid requirements and will prepare the bid documents.
